A meeting of the Garrison Diversion Conservancy District Municipal, Rural & Industrial (MR&I) Committee was held on October 19, 2023. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Kaiser at 11:12 a.m.

The meeting was recorded to assist with compilation of the minutes.

READING OF THE MINUTES

Motion by Director Rogers to dispense with the reading and approve the August 24, 2023, MR&I Committee minutes. Second by Director Krueger. Upon voice vote, motion carried.

WATER SUPPY ASSISTANCE GRANT APPLICATION

Crop Damages - - Chairperson Kaiser informed the committee there has been a question as to whether crop damages should be eligible for funding assistance under the Water Supply Assistance Grant Program (WSAGP) guidelines. This would allow for the funding eligibility of crop damages resulting from the installation of a rural water line.

After committee discussion, it was agreed payment for crop damages would not be eligible for funding under the WSAGP guidelines.

Motion by Director Kassian to add crop damages as an ineligible project expense under the Water Supply Assistance Grant Program guidelines. Second by Director Walter. Upon voice vote, motion carried.

REVIEW OF WATER SUPPLY ASSISTANCE GRANT APPLICATIONS

Rural Water Requests

East Central Regional Water District

Michael Smith is requesting \$10,000 through East Central Water District for installation of a rural water line to his property in Traill County. The total estimated project cost is \$24,222. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex II.

Greater Ramsey Water District

Steve Wood is requesting \$2,150 through Greater Ramsey Water District for a rural water hookup to his residence in Ramsey County. This application is for emergency assistance as his current well system is failing. The total estimated project cost is \$6,800. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex III.

Southeast Water Users District

Darrin & Alissa Steffens are requesting \$7,625 through Southeast Water Users District for a rural water line to their residence in Richland County. The total estimated project cost is \$17,750. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex IV.

Stutsman Rural Water District

Zac Browning is requesting \$8,250 through Stutsman Rural Water District for a rural water hookup for livestock in Stutsman County. The total estimated project cost is \$19,000. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex V.

Gene Jessen is requesting \$10,000 through Stutsman Rural Water District for a rural water hookup at his residence near Ypsilanti located in Stutsman County. The total estimated project cost is \$37,000. This application is for emergency assistance due to the failure of his existing well. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex VI.

Dennis & Tammera Stebner are currently experiencing issues with their existing well, thus, they are requesting assistance in the amount of \$4,000 through Stutsman Rural Water District for a rural water hookup at their residence north of Woodworth in Stutsman County. The total estimated project cost is \$10,500. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex VII.

CONSIDERATION OF FUNDING

Motion by Director Rogers and second by Director Krueger to approve funding in the amount of \$42,025 for allocation to the following projects:

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$10,000 to East Central Regional Water District for installation of a rural water line at the property of Michael Smith located in Traill County.

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$2,150 to Greater Ramsey Water District for a rural water hookup to the Steve Wood residence located in Ramsey County.

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$7,625 to Southeast Water Users District for installation of a rural water line to the residence of Darrin and Alissa Steffens located in Richland County.

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$8,250 to Stutsman Rural Water District to install rural water for livestock for Zac Browning in Stutsman County.

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$10,000 to Stutsman Rural Water District for installation of a water line at the residence of Gene Jessen located near Ypsilanti in Stutsman County.

Up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$4,000 to Stutsman Rural Water District for installation of a rural water line at the Dennis and Tammera Stebner residence north of Woodworth in Stutsman County.

Upon roll call vote, the following directors voted aye: Kaiser, Kassian, Krueger, Rogers and Walter. Those voting nay: none. Absent and not voting: Blanchfield. Motion carried.

Southeast Water Users District

The City of Ludden is requesting \$7,550 through Southeast Water Users District for rural water service to Ludden located in Lovell Township in Dickey County. The total estimated project cost is \$17,600. A copy of the grant application is attached to these minutes as Annex VIII.

Jay Anderson, Vice Chairman, Garrison Diversion, and, Board Member of Southeast Water Users District, reported the water district currently has a line going by the City of Ludden. Ludden is a small, rural ag community with around 10-12 hookups. The people on the north side of the road are already hooked up to South East Water Users District. The plan is to get rural water to the people on the south side of the road. The drinking water currently does not meet State Health Department requirements.

Motion by Director Walter to approve up to 50 percent of the local, non-federal share of the eligible costs not to exceed \$7,550 to Southeast Water Users District for installation of a water line for the City of Ludden located in Dickey County. Second by Director Kassian. Upon roll call vote, the following directors voted aye: Kaiser, Kassian, Krueger, Rogers and Walter. Those voting nay: none. Absent and not voting: Blanchfield. Motion carried.



This FY2024 Second quarter report is for the State of North Dakota Municipal, Rural, and Industrial (MR&I) Water Supply Program. Enclosed are tables for the MR&I project funding and expenditures, and a project status summary.

Eastern North Dakota Alternate Water Supply – The Eastern North Dakota Alternate Water Supply (ENDAWS) project is installation of 32 miles of transmission line from the McClusky Canal to serve as an alternate water supply for the Red River Valley Water Supply Project to provide a supplemental water supply in the event of drought conditions. Estimated cost is \$5,160,000 for 30 percent design and land acquisition. The 75 percent funding of \$3,870,000 includes a 2021 grant of \$2,370,000 and a 2023 grant of \$1,500,000.

Northwest Area Water Supply – The Northwest Area Water Supply (NAWS) project is a main transmission water supply project to serve approximately 81,000 people through connections with 14 communities and three rural water systems in north central North Dakota.

The Biota Water Treatment Plant (Contract 7-2A/4-1A) has an overall estimated cost of \$64.1 million. The grant funding of \$62,812,673 includes a 2018 grant of \$4,917,164, a 2020 grant of \$10,995,000, a 2021 grant of \$18,781,827, a 2022 grant of \$20,418,682, and a 2023 grant of \$7,700,000.

The Minot Water Treatment Plant Phase II (Contract 7-1B) has an overall estimated cost of \$32 million. The grant funding is \$14,859,836.

The Snake Creek Intake Modifications (Contract 6-1A) includes procurement, demolition, and construction contracts for all work inside the existing Snake Creek facilities. Estimated cost is \$48.8 million. The grant funding is \$0 million.

Lansford Reservoir and Pump Station (Contract 4-3A/5-3A) is a 4.5-million-gallon reservoir and 2,500-gallon per minute pump station with an estimated cost of \$11.6 million. The grant funding is \$0 million.

South Prairie Reservoir and Hydraulic Control Structure (Contract 5-1A) is a 10.5-million-gallon reservoir with an estimated cost of \$15.7 million. The grant funding is \$0 million.

Southwest Pipeline Project – Construction is continuing for the Supplemental Raw Water Intake (Contract 1-2A) with an estimated cost of \$25.6 million and a 2015 grant of \$2 million.

Construction is complete on the upgrades for the Dodge Pump Station (Contract 4-1E) and Richardton Pump Station (Contract 4-2B) with a cost of \$6,497,201.

This FY2024 second quarter report is for the State of North Dakota Municipal, Rural, and Industrial (MR&I) Water Supply Program for Bipartisan Infrastructure Law funding (BIL). Enclosed are tables for the MR&I project funding and expenditures, and a project status summary.

Northwest Area Water Supply – The Northwest Area Water Supply (NAWS) project is a main transmission water supply project to serve approximately 81,000 people through connections with 14 communities and three rural water systems in north central North Dakota.

The Biota Water Treatment Plant and Pump Station Phase II (Contract 7-2B/4-1B) has an overall estimated cost of \$49.2 million. The grant funding of \$26,645,000 includes a 2022 grant of \$21,645,000, a 2023 grant of \$5,000,000.

The Snake Creek Pumping Plant Discharge Pipeline (Contract 2-1E) includes construction of a discharge pipeline and connection to NAWS discharge pipeline inside an existing Snake Creek Pumping Plant discharge tunnel. Estimated cost is \$6.9 million. The grant funding is \$4.5 million.
